### Data Map

This Data Map is a tool to understand aging and disabilities landscape in Nevada County based on the California Master Plan for Aging’s 5 Bold Goals for 2030: 1) Housing for all Ages and Stages; 2) Health Reimagined; 3) Inclusion and Equity, not Isolation; 4) Caregiving that Works; and 5) Affordable Aging. It is made up of available data from local, state, and online sources (sources cited below). The goals of the Data Map are to assist the county in identifying strategic priorities, assessing the need for additional data collection, and establishing benchmarks for improving aging and disability needs in the county.
